WHAT IS TINY SPACES, DEEP CONNECTIONS?

Artists working in different locations than their own is a good thing - it adds not only to cultural exchange, but benefits everyone involved, including the local community of the artist's residency.

In **Tiny Spaces, Deep Connections** (TiSp from here forward), we think that while the idea of residency is just right, there are ways to improve the ways it is conducted, especially as the world is fighting against climate change, and especially as all around Europe small venues, offices and locales are being either neglected, abandoned, or simply forgotten. Therefore, we strive to extend the European network of artistic collaboration by inviting 12 artists from the EU and Ukraine for residencies in Germany, Greece and North Finland during the project.

In order to minimise the carbon footprint of the residency, travel will be done by trains and ferries, we will use small and intimate spaces for working during the travels and while in the residency, recyclable and/or reusable materials are favoured, and the local business community is involved in the residency as much as possible. The project will assist the artists every step of the way, helping them find new friends and networks on the way and settling in while at their destination.

TiSp is an EU project running from October 2024 to September 2026, led and coordinated by **Verein zur Förderung innovativer Wohn- und Lebensformen e.V.** (Inwde, Germany), with co-partners **TaikaBox** (TB, Finland), and **Communitism** (COMM, Greece). The project is co-funded by Creative Europe, and has national co-funding from the City of Oulu for the Finnish part.

The project has three distinct areas:

- 1) research artistic working while on the move
- 2) research literally small spaces for artistic work
- 3) use the local community to make the experience stronger and more effective in every location

There will be an open call for each residency, with clear instructions on how to apply, how we will select the artists, what to expect and how to proceed. The main information channel will be our website, tiny-spaces.eu, while each partner will promote the call on their own websites and their own social media.
